Look for **ch** or **tch**.

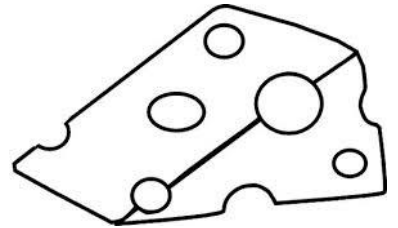
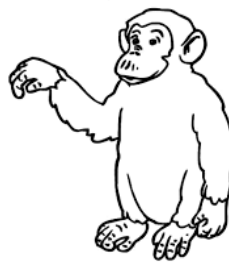
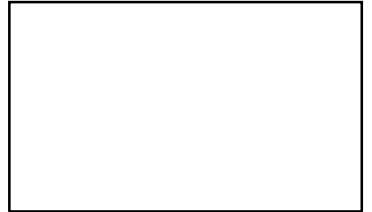
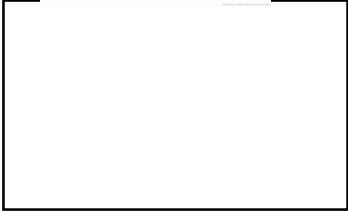
Remember to read the word to check it has the right **sound** before you highlight it.
