### **Literacy**

Weekend news- continue to write about some of the exciting things you have been doing at home! Continue to add detail and check punctuation.

- 'k' sound related to spellings- (circle the sound in the story and complete spelling activity) 'k' sound can be written cat/duck/Christmas/account/kid/talk
