The work given in this pack continues to aid your child's learning, with your support. Please continue to check over their work and discuss any mistakes and/or areas of difficulty. Listed below are the learning outcomes for literacy for the week beginning Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

### Literacy

Weekend news- continue to write about some of the exciting things you have been doing at home! Continue to add detail and check punctuation.

-'ff' sound related to spellings- (circle the sound in the story and complete sentence activity) 'ff' sound can be written fish/dolphin/laugh/huff/calf

*I have added a spelling test template if you want to print off and use on test day. There are two groups based on number facts, choose relevant PDF.*

**Please use the PowerPoint presentation to introduce 'ff' sound and complete the word sort activity included. Your child can complete the word sort on the PowerPoint using a piece of paper and headings 'ff/ph/f/gh/lf. There are additional sound activities attached for those keen learners ☺**

-Punctuation- your child has been learning to check their work for punctuation. This activity should revise what they have learned. Show your child the PowerPoint presentation, revising the different punctuation. Your child will then complete the related activity to demonstrate their understanding. Select the appropriate level for your child- There are stars located on the bottom of each page indicating the level of difficulty. ★ Level 1 ★★ Level 2 ★★★ Level 3

There is a punctuation game added to play too.

-Topic writing- Your child will review the story of Grace Darling and discuss her emotions and feelings at the time as well as the feelings and emotions of the sailors. Your child will write a diary entry for Grace Darling, detailing the night of the rescue. They should include details of how she felt throughout and how relieved she would have been to get back to the lighthouse safely. There is a PowerPoint attached to outline the key points of a diary entry. I would love to see the finished diary entries.
