SQUIGGLE

WHAT YOU NEED

Board & pens/paper & pencil

HOW TO PLAY

1. One player draws a squiggle on their board/paper making sure that both ends of the squiggle join up.



2. Each player has a colour pen or pencil and they take it in turns to colour in one section of the squiggle.
3. The players are allowed to colour any part of the squiggle as long as their colour is not next to another part of the squiggle which is coloured the same colour.



4. The winner is the last player who is able to colour in a part of the squiggle correctly.
